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

TRUCKMAN LAUNCHES TONNEAU COVER AND ROLL BAR COMBO

PICK-UPS CAN BE BOTH STYLISH AND PRACTICAL, but sometimes there is a bit of a conflict between the two qualities. Having a load bed is pretty handy but then it's also a bit handy for anyone to stick their hands in and 'borrow' tools, body parts or whatever else you have in there.

Auto Styling Truckman have a stylish answer to a practical problem, and they've added a unique twist too. They've launched the first aluminium tonneau cover that has a roll bar on it. The Upstone tonneau cover can even be fitted without any drilling, and can feature a stylish roll bar on the top near the cab.

Of course, for total security, you want the cover to lock on to the tailgate, and they offer a locking system with the cover. It just needs four holes drilled in the tailgate and there you are, all safe and secure. The system even reduces fuel consumption as it lowers drag over the load bed.

The roll bar doesn't get in the way of the tonneau cover hinging up, and blends in nicely. The Upstone tonneau cover comes in silver or black aluminium. 
SEAT RETRIM KITS FROM BRITPART

TIME TO GIVE YOUR DEFENDER'S SEATS a new lease of life? There's a variety of high-cost options to choose from, and extremely good some of them are too.

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But if a full bespoke leather interior is a bit rich for you (or you've got a truck whose seats exist on a diet of mud, crumbs and dog), these new retrim kits from Britpart offer a DIY answer that won't break either the bank or, if they take one for the team, your heart.

Each kit includes pre-shaped foam and outer covers for the cushion and squab, a headrest cover and all the rods, retainers and fixings required to attach these to the frame of your seat. There are two different Outer Seat kits, one to suit trucks from the start of manufacture to 2007 and the other for Puma models from 2007 on, as well as a third Centre Seat kit for 1990-on Defenders.



If yours is a pre-2007 model, the choice of fabric styles includes vinyl twill, Techno, black, grey and XS-style blackand-charcoal. For Pumas and centre seats, it's the same lineup minus the XS-style option.

Prices vary depending on the fabric – and of course the dealer you're buying from. But as a rough rule of thumb, you can expect to pay from about £55 including VAT for a Centre Seat kit, and from about £70-100 for an Outer Seat.



YOU KNOW THE FEELING. The weather's getting hotter, even a bit stickier, and your rear is heating up far more than your front. With summer allegedly coming, now is the time to do something about that sweaty area behind you. Fortunately Britpart have a cooling solution.

RUGGED RIDGE has come up with a practical Rear Cargo Cover for your Jeep. It's a fabric cover that goes into the cargo area and is secured with a flexible side retention system. It means you can have the rear seats fully or partly folded, yet a front curtain wall will stop pets or whatever from coming forward into the main cabin area.

The material it's made from is a water-resistant woven ballistic fabric, so it'll keep out dirt, debris and of course pets. Since these were designed in Georgia, USA, we're assuming this includes pets with big fangs or big claws.
